(2) As a member of a sister church where records have been lost or destroyed.  
(3) As a Christian who has experienced believer's baptism by immersion but is now leading you into the Baptist church because it accords with your beliefs.

**By baptism** ~ As a Christian believer of another denomination, not having experienced believer's baptism by immersion, you come during the invitation expressing a desire to unite with the fellowship through baptism.
